- Punctuality, attention to details, and adherence to safety guidelines.
- Required: criminal record check
  - Fee paid by volunteer and can refunded after three (3) months of active volunteering.





### **Job Description:**

- Excellent Organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision, follow instructions and work at a fast and safe pace.
- Confidentiality is expected.
- Unload donated items from vehicles upon arrival.
- Ensures stock in the food distribution room are sorted, stored properly.
- Ensures protocols and procedures are adhered to inside and outside during distribution.
- Ensures the sorting area is safe; maintain clear walkways and ensure that all storage space is clean and tidy.

### **Working Conditions:**

- Flexible schedule, minimum shift duration of three (3) hours.
- Available on Food Bank days, mornings and afternoons on Wednesdays and Thursdays.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time, perform moderate amounts of lifting (20lbs), bending, and stretching.
- Reports to a Food Bank Worker at the Journey to Life Centre with oversight from the Programs Services Director
- Performance Evaluation two (2) months after start date
